III. The mixed Notion made up of Position and Place,* or the Applica|tion of the parts of a Body to the parts of Place, respectively, is styled SITUATION, Seat, set, site, lying, standing, pitch, plant, Position, placing; to which may be annexed, by way of affinity, that respect of the imagi|nary face of a thing towards some other thing or place, called VER|GENCY, tending, leaning, inclining, hanker, toward, upon that hand, Rhombe.

 - MIDDLE, Intermediate, Mean, Core, Heart, Wast, main body, Noon, between both, Interim, Interval.
 - EXTREME, Term, last, end, utter, utmost, peripheral
 - END, final, last, extremity, ultimate, surcease, terminate, expire, in fine.
 - BEGINNING, First.
 - Superficies; the outmost parts of which, being considered either with relation to the thing it self: or some other thing to which it is ad|joyned, is commonly styled
 - SIDE, Flank, Wing, Cheek, lateral, collateral, Limb, Rim, Brim, Brink, Edge-wise, Hem, Ridg, Skirt, Lift, Selvage, Welt, Gard, Eaves, Battlement.
