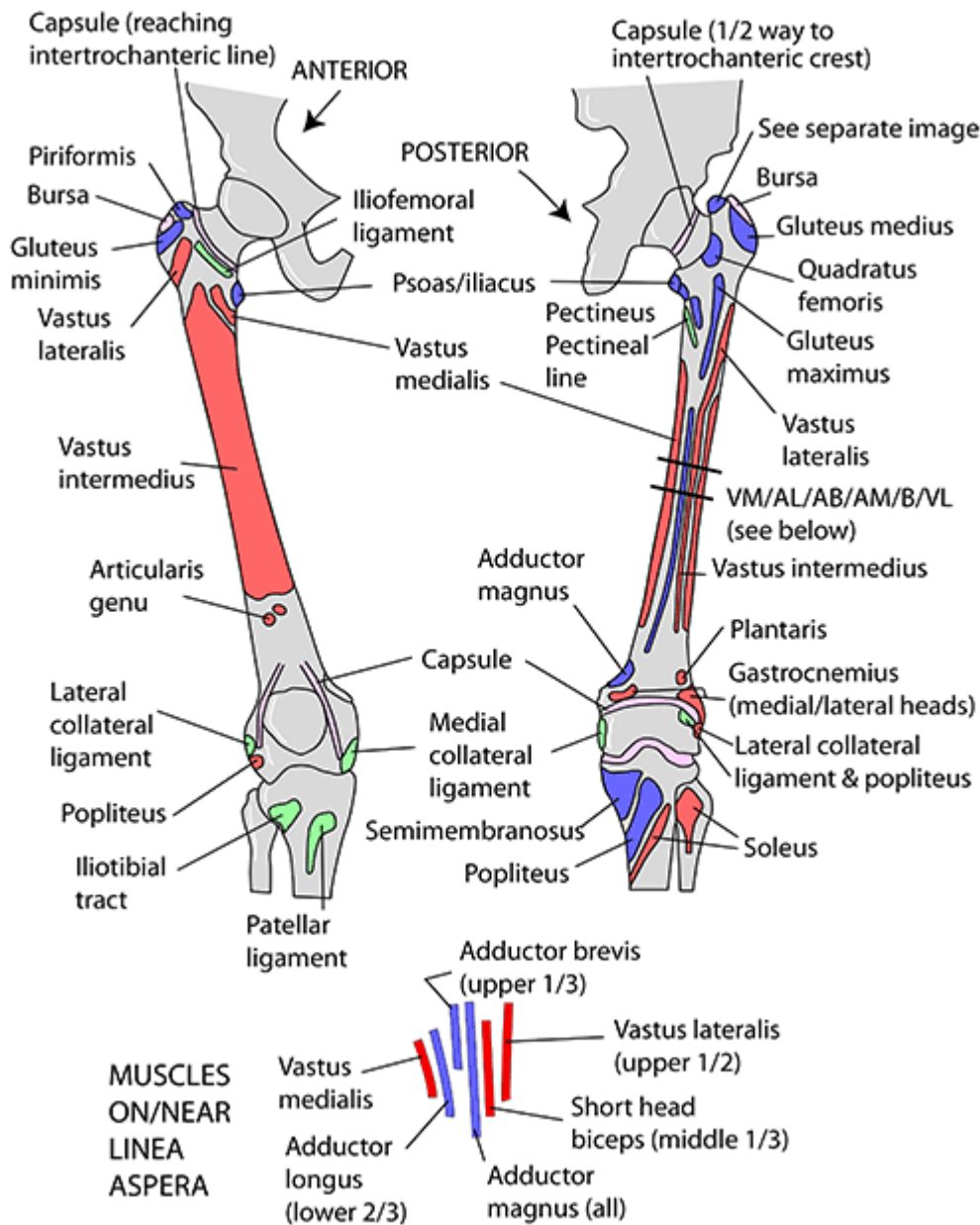


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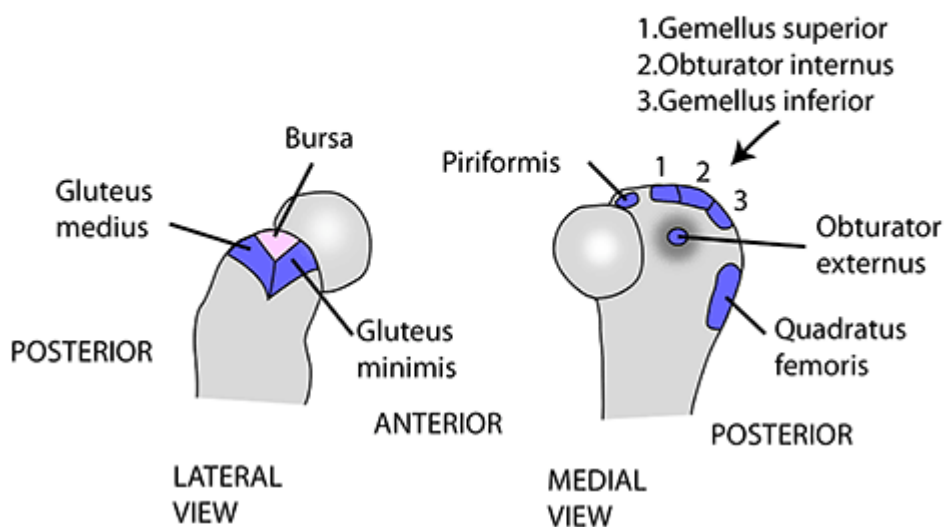

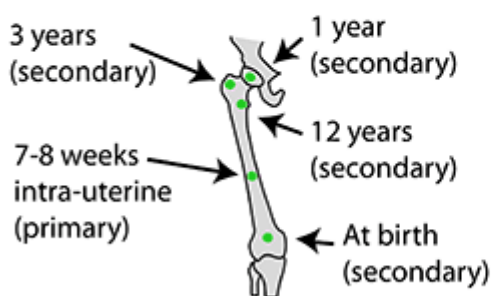
ATTACHMENTS TO RIGHT FEMUR 1

OSSIFICATION OF FEMUR



NOTES:

- Branch of obturator artery supplies fovea of femoral head via ligamentum teres.
- Growing ends of lower limb is either side of knee.
- Nutrient arteries enter obliquely at growing end.
- Femur is 1st long bone to appear at 7 weeks.
